

## Doctrine & Covenants 98:4-10

4 And now, verily I say unto you concerning the <sup>a</sup>laws of the land, it is my will that my people should observe to do all things whatsoever I command them.

5 And that <sup>a</sup>law of the land which is <sup>b</sup>constitutional, supporting that principle of freedom in maintaining rights and privileges, belongs to all mankind, and is justifiable before me.

6 Therefore, I, the Lord, justify you, and your brethren of my church, in befriending that law which is the <sup>a</sup>constitutional law of the land;

7 And as pertaining to law of man, whatsoever is more or less than this, cometh of evil.

8 I, the Lord God, make you <sup>a</sup>free, therefore ye are free indeed; and the law also maketh you free.

9 Nevertheless, when the <sup>a</sup>wicked <sup>b</sup>rule the people mourn.

10 Wherefore, <sup>a</sup>honest men and wise men should be sought for diligently, and good men and wise men ye should observe to uphold; otherwise whatsoever is less than these cometh of evil.

## Doctrine & Covenants 101:76-80

76 And again I say unto you, those who have been scattered by their enemies, it is my will that they should continue to importune for redress, and redemption, by the hands of those who are placed as rulers and are in authority over you—

77 According to the laws and <sup>a</sup>constitution of the people, which I have suffered to be established, and should be maintained for the <sup>b</sup>rights and protection of all flesh, according to just and holy principles;

78 That every man may act in doctrine and principle pertaining to futurity, according to the moral <sup>a</sup>agency which I have given unto him, that every man may be <sup>b</sup>accountable for his own sins in the day of <sup>c</sup>judgment.

79 Therefore, it is not right that any man should be in <sup>a</sup>bondage one to another.

80 And for this purpose have I established the <sup>a</sup>Constitution of this land, by the hands of wise men whom I raised up unto this very purpose, and redeemed the land by the <sup>b</sup>shedding of blood.

#### **Doctrine & Covenants 58:21**

21 Let no man break the <sup>a</sup>laws of the land, for he that keepeth the laws of God hath no need to break the laws of the land.

#### **Doctrine & Covenants 109:54**

54 Have mercy, O Lord, upon all the <sup>a</sup>nations of the earth; have mercy upon the rulers of our land; may those principles, which were so honorably and nobly defended, namely, the <sup>b</sup>Constitution of our land, by our fathers, be established forever.

#### **Articles of Faith, #12**

12 We believe in being <sup>a</sup>subject to <sup>b</sup>kings, presidents, rulers, and magistrates, in <sup>c</sup>obeying, honoring, and sustaining the <sup>d</sup>law.
